TIOGA COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE – JULY 18, 2020

Owego, NY – Tioga County Legislative Chairwoman Sauerbrey reported the following Tioga County COVID-19 Statistics:

- **174 Confirmed Cases** – Total confirmed cases, to date.
- **76 Individuals in Mandatory Quarantine.** These are individuals who have had close contact (6 ft.) with someone who has tested positive, but is not displaying symptoms for COVID-19; or individuals that have traveled to China, Iran, Japan, South Korea, or Italy and is displaying symptoms of COVID-19.
- **133 Recovered** – Total number of individuals who had a confirmed case of COVID-19 and are now symptom and fever-free that meet the criteria to be released from Isolation.
- **24 Deaths**

*This is a snapshot of data provided to Tioga County Public Health at this point in time.
Administered tests are tracked in various ways. Test results are reported.*

Tioga County Legislative Chairwoman Sauerbrey reported the Tioga County Public Health Department has been notified that an individual who ate at the Blue Dolphin Restaurant in Apalachin, NY on July 12th has tested positive for the coronavirus.

Officials say anyone who was at the restaurant on that date between 1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m. is asked to self-quarantine until July 26th.

If anyone who was at the Blue Dolphin on July 12th becomes symptomatic of COVID-19, officials urge them to contact their health care provider.
