


BROWN ROAD OVER EAST BRANCH OWEGO CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Tioga County, in cooperation with the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is in the process of developing preliminary plans for the Replacement of the bridge carrying Brown Road over the East Branch of Owego Creek.

This project proposes to replace the existing 4 span open steel deck bridge with a single span bridge that has a concrete bridge deck supported by steel girders that spans the creek. The length and width of the bridge will be increased to meet current design standards. The existing bridge is already closed due to its poor condition.

The open steel decked bridge is in a deteriorated condition and has a history of overtopping during high flow events. The proposed bridge will be built higher to reduce the potential for Brown Road to be overtopped during a 100-year flood event. The proposed design will also reduce the potential for flooding upstream of the bridge.

The estimated construction cost for this project is approximately \$2.11 million. Construction is anticipated to be completed during the 2027 construction season. This project is funded through a combination of Federal, State, and County funding.

This informational flyer is being distributed as part of the continuing efforts by NYSDOT, FHWA, and the Tioga County Department of Public Works to encourage public input into the development of transportation projects.
