- Community Residences can house anywhere from 8-14 individuals and is staffed 24/7. Our dedicated staff works intensely with residents in this Medicaid funded program to formulate individualized goals in areas of medication management / training, life skills training, and services / interventions that promote health and wellness. Group living programs are intended to transition residents to more independent settings as soon as possible
- Treatment Apartments are OMH-licensed residential units of one, two, or three bedrooms with visiting staff who provide individualized Medicaid-reimbursed services similar to, but generally less intensive than, those offered in a group living setting. Residents are expected to transition to more independent living when able. On-call is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. https://rehab.org/housing-options/
